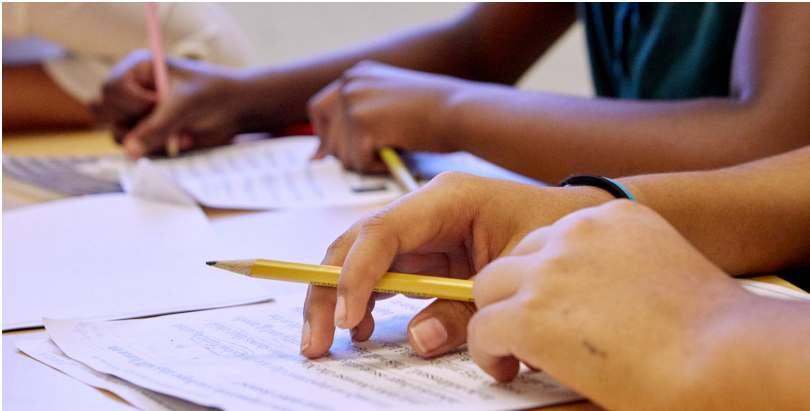

DEADLINES AND IMPORTANT DATES

TRAINING

- One-week June 30, 2017: Payment of New Leaders fee is due (in full)
- July 10, 2017: First day of summer training (Induction/Intensive)
- August 28, 2017: ASPDP registration opens
- September 24, 2017: ASPDP registration deadline
